Re: Application of *Compat Transportation LLC* for Paratransit authority, 591 Branch Court, Hazleton, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania 18201. (646) 752-7801.

To whom it may concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your application for Paratransit authority at Docket No. A-2025-3056527 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience shall not be granted for the following reason(s):

- **Failure to establish fitness.** The Commission sent you a letter requesting that you submit a revised balance sheet along with support documentation to exhibit the applicant's financial position only, as co-mingling personal assets is not permissible. You were also encouraged to consult an attorney or financial expert familiar with regulated Motor Carrier proceedings in preparation for this required information. Also, in this letter it was expressed your account should now be filled and ready to commence operations. You were also advised to transfer any personal assets prior to your submission. The requested revision of the balance sheet and support documentation was omitted from your submission. Your response indicated that the applicant does not own a vehicle, nor does it have a financial account. Also, a plan to transfer personal assets was omitted. With cash assets of only \$1000 and no tangible assets, the applicant failed to prove it has suitable finances to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable service. It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to acquire a vehicle, maintain insurance, and ensure continuance maintenance. The record demonstrates that the applicant does not have sufficient capital necessary to serve the territory requested. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Please know, you can reapply when ready to commence operations.

For this reason(s), your application is **DENIED** and **DISMISSED**.

APPEAL RIGHTS

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission are advised to open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by mail. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by mail.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. *See* 52 Pa. Code §§1.31 and 5.44. Below is a sample Verification:
