RE: Act 127 Pipeline Registration

Dear Mr. Spear:

This letter acknowledges receipt of your notification to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) on August 8, 2025, regarding the cessation of operations of Leatherstocking Pipeline Company, LLC (Leatherstocking) as of May 2024. You state that all equipment subject to Act 127 has been decommissioned, the pipeline has been purged and formally taken out of service, and that while some assets have been sold, the majority remain decommissioned and on-site.

You state that, given the decommissioning of its single pipeline asset and the sale of portions of that asset, Leatherstocking no longer owns or operates equipment or facilities in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the transportation of gas or hazardous liquids by pipeline. Accordingly, you request cancellation of Leatherstocking's Act 127 registration. Therefore, the Commission will remove Leatherstocking from its registry of pipeline operators.

The Commission reminds Leatherstocking that if it were to acquire any jurisdictional assets in the future, it must file an Initial Registration Form with the Commission in order to comply with the mandates of Act 127.
