#### Objection to PPL Exhibit 9- Form Termination Notice

Pursuant to the prehearing order and the established deadline for submission of exhibits, Complainant respectfully submits this objection to PPL's Exhibit 9. This exhibit should be excluded from the evidentiary record for the reasons set forth below.

#### Grounds for Objection

- 1. Lack of Relevance:** Exhibit 9 is dated January 13, 2025, and pertains to a different customer account. Complainant terminated service with PPL in September 28, 2023, more than a year prior to the date of the document. Accordingly, the exhibit has no relevance to the disputed billing and collection issues in this proceeding.
- 2. Prejudicial and Misleading:** Including documentation for another customer in this proceeding risks misleading the tribunal and creates confusion as to the facts in dispute. Allowing Exhibit 9 into evidence would unfairly prejudice the Complainant by suggesting account activity that is wholly unrelated to her.
- 3. Reliability of Recordkeeping:** The inclusion of an exhibit belonging to another customer raises serious concerns regarding PPL's accuracy and reliability of its records as presented in this case. This error undermines the credibility of PPL's submissions generally and casts doubt on the integrity of its documentation.

#### Request for Relief

For the foregoing reasons, Complainant respectfully requests that Exhibit 9 be excluded from the evidentiary record. In the alternative, Complainant requests that the Administrative Law Judge take judicial notice of the inaccuracy of Exhibit 9 and give it no evidentiary weight.
