AND NOW, comes Respondent, Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC (“Peoples”) by and through its counsel, Jennifer Petrisek, and files this Motion for Continuance in accordance with Commission Regulations 5.103, 52 Pa. Code §5.103:

1. The above-captioned Formal Complaint is scheduled for a Telephonic Hearing before Administrative Law Judge Emily DeVoe on Thursday, August 28th at 10:00 am.
2. Major Energy Services LLC was previously added as an Additional Respondent to the Docket, as they provided commodity, under Energy Choice regulations, from 12/17/24-2/17/25, to Mr. Albert’s deceased mother’s natural gas account.
3. Major Energy Services LLC purchased certain contracts from Tomorrow Energy in Fall, 2024.
4. Complainant’s concerns in the Formal Complaint primarily involve a time period in which Tomorrow Energy provided commodity, under Energy Choice regulations, to Mr. Albert’s deceased mother’s natural gas account from 10/15/19 through 12/16/24.
5. As Tomorrow Energy was the initial commodity provider for the account in question, and would have enrolled the account in question and would be in control of the records related to such enrollment, the Parties request a Continuance of the Hearing in order to join Tomorrow Energy as an indispensable party to this proceeding.

6. Respondent has served a copy of this Motion on Complainant and Major Energy in accordance with the attached Certificate of Service and also communicated with both parties regarding this request.
7. Complainant and Major Energy agreed to request a Continuance to the Hearing Date.
