FINAL ORDER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 332(h) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §332(h), the decision of Administrative Law Judge Emily I. DeVoe dated July 29, 2025, has become final without further Commission action;

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Joint Petition for Approval of Unanimous Settlement filed in this proceeding by Pennsylvania-American Water Company, Corner Water Supply and

Service Corporation, the Office of Consumer Advocate, and the Office of Small Business Advocate is approved without modification.

2. That the Joint Application of Pennsylvania-American Water Company and Corner Water Supply and Service Corporation under Sections 1120(a)(1)-(3) of the Public Utility Code, for approval of (1) the transfer, by sale, of all assets, property, and rights of Corner Water owned and used in connection with its water system (System) to PAWC, (2) the right of PAWC to begin to offer, render, furnish and supply water service to the public in portions of Elk and Paint Townships, Clarion County, Pennsylvania, currently served by Corner, and (3) the abandonment by Corner of all water service to the public, docketed at Docket Nos. A-2025-3052745 and A-2025-3052747 is approved, as modified by the Joint Petition for Approval of Unanimous Settlement filed in this proceeding.

3. That the Joint Petitioners shall comply with the terms and conditions of the Settlement submitted in this proceeding as though each term and condition stated therein had been the subject of an individual ordering paragraph.

4. That the Protest filed by the Office of Consumer Advocate in this proceeding is deemed satisfied.


5. That the Protest filed by the Office of Small Business Advocate in this proceeding is deemed satisfied.

6. That the Secretary shall issue all necessary certificates of public convenience evidencing approval under Pennsylvania Public Utility Code 66 Pa.C.S. § 1102(a)(3) of the proposed transactions set forth in Ordering Paragraph 2 above.

7. That the Secretary shall, at the initial application docket number for the utility, issue a certificate of abandonment pursuant to Section 1102(a)(2) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 1102(a)(2), for each abandoned utility of the proposed transaction set forth in ordering Paragraph 2 above.

8. That this matter be marked closed.
