Dear Parties:

On September 3, 2025, Brightspeed of Pennsylvania, LLC (Brightspeed) filed a Letter Request for a 10-day extension to file a response to Complainant's Formal Complaint. The original response was due September 2, 2025. In its request, Brightspeed represented that it was working with Complainant to resolve Complainant's Formal Complaint and that the parties needed more time to finalize a settlement.

Based on the representations made by Brightspeed in its September 3, 2025 request, Brightspeed is granted an extension to file its responsive pleading to the above captioned Formal Complaint. Additionally, it should also be noted that any further requests for extension should include written affirmation that all parties agree to the extension.

Brightspeed's responsive pleading is due to be filed with the Commission by the close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) on September 15, 2025.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Commission records indicate the Formal Complaint was served on Brightspeed on August 13, 2025. Based upon an August 13, 2025 service date, Brightspeed's responsive pleading would be due September 2, 2025. Brightspeed's request for a ten-day extension would make the new due date Friday, September 12, 2025. However, in its request, Brightspeed proposed a new due date of September 15, 2025. Because the parties are actively engaged in settlement discussions, using a due date of the following Monday, September 15, 2025, will provide the parties an additional weekend to finalize their settlement terms and will not prejudice either party. 52 Pa. Code § 1.2(a), (d).
