Please find attached changes and additions to Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 (this tariff cancels Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 1) effective September 8th, 2025 for Tribe Moving, LLC (PA PUC Certificate #A-8925989), 2482 Hay Creek Road, Birdsboro PA 19508. This mover amended their household goods operating authority allowing them to transport shipments between points in Pennsylvania.

Charges shown in this tariff are container rates, packing & unpacking labor using their local hourly move rates (hourly packing/unpacking applies to shipments transported less than 40 miles and shipments transported in excess of 40 miles); Non-Peak Season & Peak Season hourly charges for shipments transported 40 miles or less; additional handling fees when pianos and other bulky items are included in local move shipments; travel time charges for moves performed by the hour; and charges for holding the shipment overnight for the convenience of the shipper. It also includes bulky items charges; overnight holding fee; shuttle fee when there are access issues; waiting time charges; additional fees for stairs, elevator or long carry; charges for extra stops; and "weight & milage" transportation rates for shipments transported in excess of 40 miles.

Per the PUC website, it appears that insurance forms E & H for liability & cargo coverage have been received and accepted.

This tariff is filed by Charlie Morris Consulting LLC on behalf of Carrie Mountz & Mark Mountz, Co-Owners, Tribe Moving, LLC. The Issue Date for Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 is September 5th, 2025, with an Effective Date of September 8th, 2025. Issued on one day's notice under authority of Pa. Code, Title 52, Section 23.42.

SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

SECTION 2
ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 200 - PACKING CONTAINER CHARGES

(When furnished to shipper by carrier). Rates are in dollars and cents per each unit, except as noted. (Applicable on shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported forty (40) miles or less and in excess of forty (40) miles).

NOTE A- When packing or unpacking service is requested by the customer or required by the carrier, charges will be calculated using the cost of containers shown above plus packing and unpacking labor using the hourly rates and applicable travel charge shown on Page 4 and Page 5 of this tariff.

NOTE B - In the event that two or more standard containers must be joined together because of the size, shape or character of the item or items to be packed, the charge for the container shall be the combined charge for all cartons use.

HOURLY RATES

Subject to Notes AA and 1 to 6 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3, and 4.

Hourly rates apply from the time of arrival to first point of origin (continued during all loading, transportation from first point of origin, as well as any extra stops, to final destination & unloading and dismissal of vehicle and men by shipper at destination.

The rates shown below apply to shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported 40 miles or less.

NOTE 1 -Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) are based on the day or days, or period of days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour to be considered as one-half hour.

NOTE 4 - The additional cost for specialty items are as follows (these charges are in addition to the local hourly rates on shipments transported distances of forty (40) miles or less:

Spinet/Console Piano - **\$150.00** Upright/Baby Grand Piano - **\$300.00** Carrier does not transport Grand Pianos

When flights are involved in the movement of pianos, add **\$150.00** per flight.

Grandfather Clock - **\$200.00** Bulky Items (250 pounds & over) - **\$200.00** Exercise Equipment - **\$200.00**

NOTE 5 - When transporting a shipment on a Saturday, Sunday or Holiday for the convenience of the carrier, Monday-Friday rates will apply.

NOTE 6 - When requested for the convenience of the shipper or required by the carrier, a charge of **\$250.00** per truck per night will apply for holding the shipment in the truck overnight in lieu of storage-in-transit.

NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined mileage from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter.

0 - 15 miles	1/2 hour
16 - 30 miles	1 hour
31 - 50 miles	1 1/2 hours
50 - 70 miles	2 hours

For mileage in excess of 70 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 20 miles.

MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

The charges below apply to shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported distances in excess of forty (40) miles:

OVERNIGHT HOLDING IN TRUCK (charge is per truck per night) - This charge only applies when the shipment is held overnight for the convenience of the shipper - It does not apply when shipment is delivered the following day or days based on mileage or the convenience of the carrier.	\$250.00

When due to problems with access to or from a residence (excessive long carry, steep grade, etc.), carrier may assess a charge for shuttle service. Cost for shuttle service is \$15.00 per 100 pounds (includes the shuttle vehicle and additional labor required to perform the shuttle).

When customer does not arrive at destination to accept delivery at the time agreed upon with the carrier, the carrier may assess a charge for waiting time based on \$50.00 per hour per vehicle and \$75.00 per crewmember subject to the following: For shipments transported 200 miles or less, customer is entitled to one (1) hour of waiting time at no additional charge and on shipments transported in excess of 200 miles, customer is entitled to two (2) hours of waiting time at no additional charge.

When a shipment has stairs, elevator or long carrier at origin, extra stops or long carries, the following charges will apply based on the actual weight of the shipment and subject the following:

Stairs - (a flight is defined as six steps or more) - Additional cost per flight is \$2.00 per 100 pounds

When an elevator is present at origin or destination, the additional charge per elevator is \$3.00 per 100 pounds

Long Carry - (a long carry is defined as each 50 feet or fraction thereof after the first 75 feet - Additional cost per long carry is \$2.00 per 100 pounds - (first 75 feet of a long carry is performed at no additional charge)

When an extra stop or extra stops are included in the shipment, the additional cost is \$60.00 per extra stop

SECTION 2
TRANSPORTATION RATES

Rates are in cents per 100 pounds, apply to actual weight (subject to minimum weights as provided in rules herein) and include loading and unloading and the actual movement or transportation of property from origin to destination. These rates apply to shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported in excess of forty (40) miles.

(Rate in Cents Per 100 Pounds)

Break Point indicates weight at which a lower charge develops by use of lowest weight and applicable rate in next higher weight bracket.
