Response to Data Request Letter

Dear Secretary Homsher,

Pursuant to the Commission's letter dated August 11, 2025, I respectfully submit the following responses to the requested information:

1. Vehicle Storage Location (Question 4)

The vehicle will be stored at my residence located at:
220 Lee Drive, Apt 40
Coraopolis, PA 15108

2. Driver Safety and Compliance Policy (Questions 5a–5e)

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 29.503–29.505, I have implemented the following policies for my taxi service:

a. Age Requirement (§ 29.503)

- All drivers must be at least 21 years of age to operate a vehicle in service.
- No drivers under 21 will be employed; therefore, the EMSVO exception in § 29.503(b) does not apply to this business.

b. Driving Experience

- All drivers must have at least 1 year of driving experience with a valid U.S. driver's license.

c. Driver History (§ 29.504)

- A Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) will be obtained from PennDOT and from any state of licensure during the past 3 years prior to employment.
- Frequency: Reviewed after 1 year, then every 2 years thereafter.
- Retention: Records will be retained for at least 2 years.
- Disqualification: Drivers with 3 or more moving violations in the past 3 years, or any major violation (DUI, reckless driving, license suspension), will be disqualified.

d. Criminal History (§ 29.505)

- A criminal history check will be obtained from the Pennsylvania State Police and from each state of residence for the past 12 months before employment.
- Frequency: After 1 year, then every 2 years thereafter.
- Retention: Records will be retained for at least 3 years.
- Disqualification: Any felony or misdemeanor conviction that relates adversely to safe driving, or the offenses listed in § 29.505 (including DUI, drug felonies, violent crimes, sexual offenses, or acts of terror), will result in immediate disqualification.

e. Monitoring and Reporting

- Drivers will be continuously monitored for accidents, moving violations, and criminal offenses.
- Any driver with a serious violation (DUI, reckless driving, license suspension, or use of a vehicle to commit a felony) will be immediately disqualified.
- All driver qualifications, history, and background records will be maintained in compliance with statutory retention requirements and will be available for Commission inspection upon request.
