Joint Abbreviated Securities Certificate of Shenandoah Cable Television, LLC d/b/a Shentel Communications (Shentel Cable) and Shentel Asset Entity I LLC (SAE) (collectively, "Registrants") for the issuance of various Notes up to an aggregate amount of 878,000,000 and for the Registrants to act as guarantors for the issuance of a Revolving Credit Facility in an amount up to 200,000,000. The purpose of the issuances is to pay off existing debt and terminate their existing credit facility, to pay transaction fees and expenses in connection with the issuances, and, thereafter, for working capital and general corporate purposes in support of their fiber-based operations.
