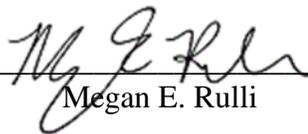

**STATUS REPORT OF
DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE MARY D. LONG:

Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”) submits the following Status Report on behalf of the Company and Audrey Edwards (“Complainant”), pursuant to the Interim Order Granting Continuance entered in this proceeding (“Interim Order”) on August 12, 2025. The Interim Order requires Duquesne Light to file a status report no later than September 10, 2025, that provides at least three alternate dates when all parties and their witnesses and are available for a rescheduled hearing.

Pursuant to the Interim Order, Counsel for Duquesne Light contacted the Complainant regarding rescheduled hearing dates as well as the status of the Complainant’s exhibit containing data from her solar panel system. The Complainant reported that she is still working to gather the data for the exhibit but that she will have the data ready to share with Duquesne Light and Your Honor by September 30, 2025. Regarding hearing dates, the parties have identified the following dates: October 30, November 6, or November 7, 2025. These dates work for both parties, for a hearing starting at either 10:00 AM or 1:30 PM.

In the interim, Duquesne Light remains willing to discuss settlement with the Complainant, and will work with the Complainant to identify whether all or some of the issues raised in the Complaint can be resolved without the need for a formal evidentiary hearing.

Duquesne Light respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judge Mary D. Long accept this Status Report.
