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**RESPONSE OF PECO ENERGY COMPANY  
TO DATA REQUESTS OF THE BUREAU OF TECHNICAL UTILITY SERVICES**

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**TUS-A-1:**

Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 6. Please explain whether the \$33 million reimbursement will be applied to the transmission costs, distribution costs, or both. If both, please provide the breakdown between transmission and distribution reimbursement.

**RESPONSE:**

PECO estimates that approximately \$8.5 million will be applied to transmission costs and approximately \$24.5 million will be applied to distribution costs.

**TUS-A-2:**

Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 6. Please explain whether PECO anticipates the reimbursements to continue from the United States Department of Energy.

**RESPONSE:**

PECO has an active federal Infrastructure and Investment Jobs Act grant contract with the U.S. Department of Energy (“DOE”) for funding, including for the 220-80 Line and 220-101 Line Project (“Project”). The DOE has indicated that all funding determinations regarding grant contracts will be communicated to recipients by the end of October. PECO intends to continue to pursue Project reimbursements and will continue to compile and submit reimbursement requests to the DOE.

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**TUS-A-3:**

Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 10. Please explain whether customer service was interrupted during the 2021 flooding. If so, please provide the approximate number of customers impacted and the approximate outage duration.

**RESPONSE:**

In advance of the 2021 flooding, PECO proactively switched out the Barbadoes Substation to prevent substantial loss of electric service for PECO customers. Due to other storm outage events, a total of 887 customers who are normally served by the Barbadoes Substation lost power for periods of time.

**TUS-A-4:**

Reference the Letter of Notification, Attachment 2, Item 8. Please provide the approximate date that PECO anticipates the completion of PJM's do no harm analysis.

**RESPONSE:**

PJM began a do no harm analysis for the Project in June 2025 but has not yet provided any results to PECO. PECO anticipates that PJM will complete the do no harm analysis in December 2025. PECO will provide the results of the do no harm analysis for the Project after PJM has provided PECO with the analysis.
