COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENA FOR PNC BANK OFFICIALS

TO THE HONORABLE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Complainant, Ifedoo Enigwe, pro se, hereby respectfully moves this Commission to issue a subpoena compelling the attendance and testimony of appropriate officials from PNC Bank at the hearing scheduled for September 30, 2025, and in support thereof states as follows:

BACKGROUND

1. This matter involves a dispute regarding the payment and alleged return of \$1,248.00 by PECO Energy Company.
2. A critical issue in this case is whether PECO Energy Company actually returned the disputed amount of \$1,248.00 to PNC Bank as claimed.
3. PNC Bank has provided a letter confirming that they have never received any money from PECO Energy Company, neither on March 19, 2025, nor at any other time.
4. Despite the existence of this letter, PECO Energy Company has failed to agree to a stipulation that would have eliminated the need for live testimony from PNC Bank officials regarding the contents of their letter.

NECESSITY OF SUBPOENA

5. The testimony of PNC Bank officials is necessary and material to establish the facts regarding whether PECO Energy Company returned the disputed funds.
6. Without the testimony of PNC Bank officials, Complainant will rely only on the letter issued by PNC as evidence regarding this essential element of the case.
7. The proposed testimony is not cumulative, as it provides first-hand knowledge of PNC Bank's records and transactions with PECO Energy Company.
8. PNC Bank officials are not likely to appear voluntarily at the hearing without a subpoena compelling their attendance.

LEGAL AUTHORITY

9. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission has the authority to issue subpoenas under 66 Pa.C.S. § 331(a) and 52 Pa. Code § 5.321.
10. A subpoena should issue when the testimony sought is relevant, material, and necessary for the proper determination of the case.

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Complainant respectfully requests that this Commission:

- A. Issue a subpoena compelling the attendance and testimony of appropriate officials from PNC Bank at the hearing scheduled for September 30, 2025;
- B. Direct that the subpoena require the witness(es) to bring all records, documents, and communications related to any alleged payments or transactions between PNC Bank and PECO Energy Company, particularly regarding the \$1,248.00 in question;
- C. Grant such other relief as this Commission deems just and proper.
