COMPLIANCE REPORT

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.591 and the Commission’s Final Order entered on August 19, 2025, in the above-captioned proceeding, Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”) hereby submits this compliance report.

1. The Commission’s Final Order directed Duquesne Light to “repair the facilities attached to the Complainant’s home and repair the sidewalk on McCandless Avenue that was damaged by the relocation of the poles.” Final Order, p. 2. Such restoration work had to be completed within 30 days of the Final Order’s entry date. *Id.* The Commission further stated that the docket would be marked closed after the Company files a report verifying that the repairs have been completed. *Id.*

2. Under Section 5.591 of the Commission’s regulations, “[a] person subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission who is required to do or perform an act by a Commission order, permit or license provision shall file with the Secretary a notice stating that the requirement has or has not been met or complied with.” 52 Pa. Code § 5.591(a). The compliance report must be “accompanied by a verification in accordance with § 1.36.” *Id.* § 5.591(b).

3. On August 20, 2025, Duquesne Light personnel repaired the one-point service connection to the Complainant's home, which entailed removing the failed one-point connection, drilling into the brick fascia mortar, and affixing a one-point connection flush with the brick fascia. Duquesne Light personnel then transferred the service to the newly established one-point connection. Photographs evidencing the repaired service connection are attached as **Exhibit A**.

4. On or around May 30, 2025, Duquesne Light personnel repaired the damaged sidewalk on McCandless Avenue, which entailed removing soil from the affected area to obtain the standard concrete depth of four inches. Rebar and bond breaker material were installed around pole and against existing concrete joints. Additionally, concrete was poured and finished to complete repair of the sidewalk in accordance to City of Pittsburgh specifications. Photographs evidencing the restored sections of sidewalk are attached as **Exhibit B**.

5. A verification signed by Corey Elzer, Supervisor of Distribution Engineering at Duquesne Light Company, verifying that the repairs identified above have been completed, is attached in compliance with 52 Pa. Code § 5.591(b) and the Commission's Final Order.

WHEREFORE, Duquesne Light Company respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission mark the above-captioned proceeding closed.
