RE: Infiltration and Inflow Study for the Exeter Township wastewater system at Docket No. A-2018-3004933

Dear Attorney Fure:

The purpose of this correspondence is to determine the status of Pennsylvania-American Water Company – Wastewater Division’s (PAWC-WD’s) Infiltration and Inflow (I&I) study of the Exeter Township wastewater system. Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 15 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (Commission’s) Opinion and Order entered October 3, 2019 (October Order), at the above referenced docket, the Commission directed that, within six months after the closing of the transaction, PAWC-WD start an I&I study for the Exeter Township wastewater system (Exeter I&I Study) and provide the results of said study, upon completion, to all Parties to the proceeding. On October 25, 2019, PAWC-WD filed a letter with the Commission that indicated PAWC-WD had closed on the acquisition of the wastewater system assets of Exeter Township on October 24, 2019.


As of the date of this letter, the status of PAWC-WD’s effort to complete the required Exeter I&I Study is unclear. Therefore, the Commission requests that PAWC-WD file a report describing the status of the Exeter I&I Study with the Secretary’s Bureau, with a copy served on the Bureau of Technical Utility Services, within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of this letter at Docket No. A-2018-3004933. The report should include the following:

- (1) A summary of PAWC-WD’s activities, listed by completion date, which have been taken to complete the Exeter I&I Study;
- (2) An outline of the remaining steps PAWC-WD will take to complete the Exeter I&I Study to include a preliminary schedule for each defined element and a projected completed date;
- (3) If PAWC-WD has completed the Exeter I&I Study, provide a copy of the completed study with a summary of findings to include, if any, PAWC-WD’s intended steps for remediation.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.44, file a petition for reconsideration from the actions of staff with the Secretary of the Commission within twenty (20) business days from the date of this letter.
