Dear Secretary Homsher:

Detailed below are the answers to the data request dated September 16, 2025, pertaining to the application of the above carrier:

1. The answers to the Application are from the sole owner of Suun LLC as executed in the verified statement. Information was completed with assistance of counsel. As to the response to Question 3 and Question 4, the ownership was mistakenly referred to as multiple. Mohammed Elsanousi is the sole owner of Suun LLC and will be directly responsible for overseeing the daily operation of the business which will begin with just one vehicle that he will be operating himself. As to Question 4 it is less apparent that he was referring to multiple owners but rather that owners and drivers alike will always maintain company cell phones.

2. In response to the multiple parts of Question 6 the Applicant intends to operate one vehicle initially which shall be operated by the sole member. The Applicant is in possession of the vehicle, but it has not been transferred over to the company and will not be transferred until the receipt of authority. Since it is not a part of the company as of yet it is not included as an asset of the business. However, upon receipt of authority it will be transferred for a nominal fee. One vehicle will be sufficient for the limited amount of business that will be received initially. Demand will be monitored regularly to determine if additional vehicles will be needed. A copy of the present deed for the intended vehicle has been attached hereto as Exhibit A.
3. The Applicant will bring in any vehicle every 2,000 miles at which time all tires and brakes will be checked thoroughly as well as oil and coolant levels, with a synthetic oil change being completed at each of these service intervals. These regular services will be conducted directly by the Applicant. Any other issues that may arise upon the daily checks of vehicles, as well as the annual inspections required by the Commonwealth will be done at local garages licensed by the Commonwealth. If a vehicle is determined to be unsafe for operation in the sole discretion of the owner, it shall be removed from service immediately and sent for the necessary repairs. The daily inspections and regular service of any vehicle should eliminate or significantly reduce the need for vehicle removal. A copy of the daily checklist is attached hereto as Exhibit B.
4. The Applicant has solicited several quotes from qualified transportation insurance providers. The initial cost for insurance for a paratransit vehicle is approximately \$9300.00. An insurance quote has been attached hereto as Exhibit C.
5. This company is a new business with only cash assets currently. The vehicle is owned by the member and therefore not included in the assets although it shall be added immediately upon receipt of authority. The financial statement supplied therefore is accurate as it can only include assets of the business and not the individual (although the assets of the business are sufficient, the individual owner will also support the business with his own assets if necessary). A copy of the business bank statement is attached hereto as Exhibit D
