**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY
FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (the “Company”) by and through its attorney, Timothy K. McHugh, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby files this Motion for Continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for October 23, 2024. In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. On or about April 25, 2025, Joshua Samuel Pennington (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) regarding 315 South Wayne Street, Lewistown, Pennsylvania (“Service Location”) under Account No. 100151295373 (“Account”), which was electronically served on the Company on or about April 28, 2025.

2. On May 19, 2025, the Company filed its Answer denying the material allegations.

3. On August 18, 2025, Administrative Law Judge Steven K. Haas (“ALJ Haas”) issued a Prehearing Order setting the date for an evidentiary hearing for October 2, 2025.

4. The Company will test Complainant’s meter to determine whether it is operating accurately within the Commission’s approved guidelines continue to address his concerns regarding his allegations of high bills.

5. However, the results of the meter test will not be available in time for the currently scheduled hearing.

6. On September 23, 2025, the Company contacted Complainant to see if he would be agreeable to a continuance of the hearing in this matter. The Complainant has not responded to the Company's request.

7. The Company respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for October 2, 2025, in this matter be continued to a later date.

II. MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

8. The Commission's regulations permit a request for continuance of a hearing upon good cause shown. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b).


9. In this case, the Company is seeking additional time to test the meter at the service location to address the Complainant's allegations of high bills.

10. The Company believes that a continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for October 2, 2025 is in the best interests of judicial economy for the Commission as well as both parties.

WHEREFORE, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company respectfully requests that the Commission issue an Order granting the Motion for Continuance.


