Dear Ms. Savage:

The Commission appreciates the cooperation extended by the officers and employees of FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (FE PA) to our audit staff during the recent Management Efficiency Investigation (MEI). We seek FE PA's further cooperation in implementing the recommendations cited in the MEI audit report.

At its Public Meeting of September 25, 2025, the Commission acknowledged receipt of FE PA's Implementation Plan submitted on September 10, 2025 and released it to the public, along with the Audit Staff's MEI report. The Commission notes that FE PA's Implementation Plan indicates acceptance of all 15 recommendations. Receipt of the Implementation Plan does not constitute acceptance by the Commission of the actions already taken, those to be taken, or the explanations and analysis provided. FE PA's implementation actions, together with any explanations and cost/benefit analyses, may be reviewed by the Commission at a later date. This review would be made to determine if FE PA has effectively implemented the recommendations.

Accordingly, the Commission directs FE PA to proceed with the September 10, 2025 Implementation Plan. The Commission's direction to proceed with the Implementation Plan should not be construed as approval of the plan.
