Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:



Request for Information

Questions for evaluation on a PUC Application require regulation compliant answers, they should be well thought out and complete, and must answer all parts of the questions asked. Please review Title 52 PA Code to ensure your answers meet that standard.

- 1.) Please fully explain how your company intends to operate. Will you entirely transport your own clients for whom you provide personal care and other services? Will you be available to the general public? Who will pay for the transportation? Will you be working on contracts? If so, with whom?
- 2.) The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. **Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements, answers to these questions are provided by reading Title 52 PA Code, which can be found on Google.** Each of your answers to sections of this question were insufficient:

- § 29.503. Age restrictions.
- § 29.504. Driver history
- § 29.505. Criminal history.

Note that answers must be provided for each of these questions regardless of whether or not members intend to drive, the policies for record review, maintenance and retention must be in place for any and all drivers.

- 3) The statement of financial position that you have provided is insufficient to be evaluated. Note that only assets in the name of the company should be included. No buildings or property unless in the name of the company. Note that values should be provided for cash, other assets, vehicles, etc. Liabilities such as business loans, rent, and other

payments should be provided. Note that the balance sheet MUST BE DATED. Your application cannot be evaluated without these vital components of information.

The purpose of the verified statement questions is to determine your ability to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable transportation. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses. Failure to do so is sufficient grounds to justify the denial of your application because you have failed to provide sufficient evidence of your fitness to operate. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings is highly encouraged.
