**Please find attached individual tariff, Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 9, effective October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025 (this tariff cancels Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 8) for Forest Hills Transfer & Storage, Inc. (PA PUC Certificate #A-00088631), 740 Stanton Street, Greensburg PA 15221.**

Changes to this tariff are an **INCREASE** to container, packing & unpacking rates for all distances; an **INCREASE** in overtime loading & unloading charges, Storage-In-Transit rates, elevator, stair & long carry rates, additional transportation charge and re-weighing charges for shipments transported in excess of 40 miles; an **INCREASE** in local hourly rates; a **CHANGE** in minimum hourly charges; a **CHANGE** in the application of the travel time charge; and an **INCREASE** in per 100 pounds transportation rates for shipments transported in excess of 40 miles.



SECTION 1  
RULES & REGULATIONS

**ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

**ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY**

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

**ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE**

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound, per article, see Governing Tariff.

**SECTION 2**  
**ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES**

**ITEM 40 - PACKING AND UNPACKING**

Rates below include packing, the use of packing containers and materials from origin to destination, and unpacking for shipments transported between points in Pennsylvania and traveling distances of 40 miles and under and distances in excess of 40 miles.

Rates do not include unpacking WHEN:

1. Shipper elects not to have unpacking performed and elects to retain the containers and specifically directs carrier or its agent not to perform unpacking.
2. Shipper elects not to have unpacking performed at time of delivery and specifically so directs carrier or its agent.
3. Shipment is delivered to a warehouse (except where delivery to warehouse is for storage-in-transit and delivery from warehouse is made within the storage-in-transit period provided in Item 60.

**SECTION 2**  
**ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES**

◆ **ITEM 50 - OVERTIME LOADING AND UNLOADING**

At the request of the shipper, owner or consignee, carrier will load and/or unload shipments on Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays or on Weekdays between the hours of 5:00PM and 8:00AM subject to an additional charge of **\$3.00** per 100 pounds for each loading and/or unloading.

◆ **ITEM 60 - STORAGE-IN-TRANSIT**

1. Where the distance between point of pick-up or delivery and warehouse is more than 40 miles, use rates Section 5.
2. Where the distance between point of pick-up or delivery and warehouse is 40 miles or less, use the following rates:

500 pounds to 999 pounds inclusive	<b>\$35.00 per 100 pounds</b>
1,000 pounds to 1,999 pounds inclusive	<b>\$30.00 per 100 pounds</b>
2,000 pounds to 1,999 pounds inclusive	<b>\$27.00 per 100 pounds</b>
4,000 pounds to 7,999 pounds inclusive	<b>\$24.00 per 100 pounds</b>
8,000 pounds and over	<b>\$18.00 per 100 pounds</b>

When a storage-in-transit shipment has been placed in a carrier's or agent's warehouse, both the carrier and the warehouse must have in their possession records showing the following:

1. An itemized list of the shipment with the Bill of Lading number noted thereon.
2. Point of origin and destination.
3. Condition of each article when received at or forwarded from the warehouse.
4. The dates when all charges, advances and payments were made or received.
5. Dates shipment was delivered into and forwarded from the warehouse.

◆ **ITEM 70 - ELEVATOR, STAIR CARRY OR LONG CARRIES**

When pick-up and/or delivery involves elevators, stairs or long carries on shipments transported distances in excess of 40 miles, the following additional charges will be assessed:

Elevators	<b>\$3.00 per 100 pounds for one or more floors</b>
Stairs	<b>\$2.00 per 100 pounds for each flight</b>
Long Carriers	<b>\$2.00 per 100 pounds per long carry (long carry is each 50 feet or fraction thereof after the first 75 feet)</b>

All floors inside a single family dwelling shall be considered ground floor.

SECTION 2

ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

**ITEM 80 - PIANOS, ORGANS, AND OTHER BULKY ARTICLES**

When a piano or other bulky article is included in a shipment transported a distance in excess of 40 miles, the following additional handling fees will apply per each piano or bulky article:

Handling Charge for pipe organs, all grand pianos, and all other pianos in excess of 38 inches in height:	<b>\$75.00</b>
Handling Charge for all other types of organs and all other pianos 38 inches or less in height:	<b>\$35.00</b>
FLIGHT CARRY CHARGE - INSIDE A BUILDING OR HOUSE:	
First flight:	<b>\$20.00</b>
Each Additional Flight:	<b>\$20.00</b>
FLIGHT CARRY CHARGE - OUTSIDE A BUILDING OR HOUSE:	
First flight:	<b>\$20.00</b>
Each additional step over 20 steps:	<b>\$1.00</b>

Flights are considered to be a minimum of 8 steps but not more than 20 steps.

Motorcycles, Motorbikes, Go-Karts, All Terrain Vehicles, Riding Lawnmowers or Tractors (less than 25hp), Snow Mobiles, Motorized Golf Carts, Jet Skis, Trailers (less than 14 feet in length), canoes, rowboats and kayaks (less than 14 feet in length) - excluding toys and articles cable of being convenient hand carried by one person:	<b>\$65.00</b>
Farm Equipment and Implements; Farm Trailers or Tractors (25 hp and over):	<b>\$250.00</b>
Playhouses, Tool Sheds, Utility Sheds, Animal Houses/Kennels, Bath or Hot Tubs, Jacuzzis (transported setup, not dismantled) - Excluding articles capable of being conveniently hand carrier by one person:	<b>\$125.00</b>
Grandfather or Grandmother Clocks and Large Screen TVs:	<b>\$50.00</b>

Weight Additives (When a shipment includes any of the following item(s), the transportation charges will be based on the actual weight of the item plus a weight additive based on the volume of the item using a factor based on seven (7) pounds per cubic foot.

Airplanes, Gliders, Ultralights, Camper Shells (any size), Boats, Sailboats, Rowboats, Canoes and Kayaks (14 feet or greater in length):

**ITEM 90 - AUTOMOBILES**

When an automobile is transported with other household goods, a flat rate will apply:	Per Vehicle:	<b>\$500.00</b>

**ITEM 100 - EXTRA PICK-UP OR DELIVERY**

SECTION 2  
ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

**ITEM 110 - ADDITIONAL TRANSPORTATION CHARGE**

On all shipments having an origin or destination in the following area, (see Notes 1 and 2 below), the charges shown will apply:

SERVICE AREA	PER	◆ RATES (in dollars and cents)
ALL COUNTIES WITHIN PENNSYLVANIA	100 Pounds	\$4.00

NOTE 1 - The Additional Transportation Charge will apply at both origin and destination except when both origin and destination are located within the same county. When this is the case, the Additional Transportation Charge will apply only at origin.

NOTE 2 - The Additional Transportation Charge will be based on the weight at which the transportation charges are based.

**ITEM 120 - RE-WEIGHING AND NOTIFICATION OF CHARGE EXPENSE**

◆ (A) The carrier upon request of shipper, owner or consignee made prior to delivery of a shipment and when practical to do so, will reweigh the shipment. No charge will be made if the difference between the two net scale weights exceeds 100 pounds on shipments weighing 5,000 pounds or less and two percent (2%) of the lower net scale weight on shipments weighing more than 5,000 pounds. If the difference between the two net scale weights is less than stated above, a charge of **\$75.00** will be assessed by the carrier for the reweighing servicer. The lower of the two net scale weights shall be used for determining the applicable charges.

(B) When requested by shipper to do so, carrier will notify shipper by telegraph, telephone (phone call or test) or email (as requested by the shipper) of weight and/or charges upon ascertainment of same. Actual cost of such telegraphic or telephonic notification, if any, shall be added to the carrier's charges and collected from the shipper.

SECTION 3  
SCHEDULE OF RATES

**ITEM 130 - HOURLY RATES**

Hourly rates apply to shipments transported between points in Pennsylvania traveling distances of 40 miles and less. Rates are subject to Notes 1 to 9 and AA below. The transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3, and 4.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days, or period of days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour considered as one-half hour.

NOTE 4 - When a holiday falls on a Saturday or Weekday, the rates named in Columns 1 and 2 shall be applicable.

**ITEM 130 - HOURLY RATES**

(continued from previous page)

▲ NOTE 5 - The minimum total transportation charges on Sundays and Holidays (any hour): Six (6) hours plus applicable travel time at rates named in Columns 1 and 2. The minimum total transportation charges on Saturdays (any hour) and Weekdays (5:01PM to 7:59AM): Three (3) hours plus applicable travel time at rates named in Columns 1 and 3. The minimum total transportation charges Monday-Friday (8:00AM to 5:00PM): Two (2) hours plus applicable travel charge at rates named in Columns 1 and 4.

NOTE 6 - Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor or supervisors as requested by the shipper or required by the carrier. Hourly rate for each supervisor is shown above. The total cost for the supervisor(s) will be computed in the same manner as all other local hourly charges.

▲ NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter.

0 - 15 miles	1/2 hour
16 - 30 miles	1 hour
31 - 50 miles	1 1/2 hours
51 - 70 miles	2 hours

For mileage in excess of 70 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 20 miles.

SECTION 5  
TRANSPORTATION RATES

◆ **ITEM 140 - SHIPMENTS TRANSPORTED BETWEEN POINTS IN PENNSLVANIA IN EXCESS OF FORTY (40) MILES**

The total transportation charges on any shipment shall not exceed the charge that would apply on the same shipment under the next greater unit of weight at rate applicable to such next greater unit of weight.
