1. Previously you indicated that you intended to place two Chevrolet Suburbans into service, and you provide an insurance quote in support of this. You also indicate that no loans or leases currently exist and that you intend to transfer the vehicles once authority is granted; however, you provide no explanation as to how those vehicle will be transferred to the applicant.

Is the transfer to be a purchase, a lease, or a gift?

- a. If a purchase or a lease, what are the terms associated with the transfer (total cost, monthly cost, and duration of the terms)?
  - b. If the transfer is a gift; from whom is the gift being provided, and are there any associated terms or encumbrances?
2. Your provided insurance quote indicates an expected annual expense of \$9,293. What are the terms of the policy purchase?
    - a. Is the entire premium due upfront, or is the premium to be broken down into monthly payments?
    - b. If monthly payments, what is the projected monthly expense?
  3. You have provided a cash balance of \$8,825 (as of August 27, 2025). You have also provided a projected insurance expense of \$9,293, and you have not yet provided an explanation for how you intend to fund/compensate for vehicle purchases (leases, etc.).

Based upon the anticipated premiums, possible vehicle purchase expenses, and a relatively low cash balance; how do you anticipate paying for vehicle maintenance expenses on two relatively high mileage vehicles (one with 156k miles and another with 268k miles)?

- a. What is your projected monthly vehicle maintenance cost per vehicle?
- b. What is your TOTAL projected monthly output for all expenses (insurance, maintenance, office supplies, necessary services, utilities, tax liability, etc.)?
- c. What is your projected monthly revenue?
