**INTERIM ORDER  
GRANTING A REQUEST FOR A CONTINUANCE**

James Iorfido (Complainant) filed a formal complaint against Duquesne Light Company on May 5, 2025. The Complainant alleged that Duquesne Light installed a transformer on his property. According to the Complainant, workers removed survey markers which were recently installed on his property. As relief the Complainant wants Duquesne Light to remove the transformer and to “survey my property and replace survey pins.”

Duquesne Light filed an answer on May 27, 2025. Duquesne Light admitted that it installed transformers within its right-of-way over the Complainant’s property. Duquesne Light denied that it did not notify the Complainant of the project. Duquesne Light admitted that it removed the Complainant’s wooden survey stake and metal property pin from the right-of-way but denied that it is responsible for replacing them.

Duquesne Light filed preliminary objections which were dismissed by interim order entered on July 1, 2025. Also on July 1, 2025, a hearing was scheduled for September 29, 2025.

By email on September 22, 2025, Duquesne Light requested a continuance of the September 29, 2025, hearing. Counsel for Duquesne Light reported that the Parties had engaged in productive settlement discussions and required additional time in order to finalize the details

of their agreement. The Complainant agreed with the request to continue the hearing. September 29, 2025, hearing was cancelled.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the request for a continuance by Duquesne Light Company is granted.
2. That on or before **October 22, 2025**, counsel for Duquesne Light Company shall file a joint status report which includes an update regarding the status of the Parties' settlement discussions. In the event that settlement discussions remain productive, the proceedings may remain continued. If the Parties believe that it is appropriate to reschedule the hearing, the status report shall include three alternate dates when both the parties and their witnesses are available for hearing.
3. That in the event a certificate of satisfaction is filed on or before October 22, 2025, no status report is required.
4. That the parties are reminded that Commission policy encourages settlement and that they should continue to communicate with each other in an attempt to resolve their dispute.
