On November 1, 2023, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC). This rulemaking amends 52 Pa. Code §§ 54.75, 58.1 – 58.19, and 62.5. The proposed regulation was published in the December 2, 2023 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a public comment period ending on February 15, 2024. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on July 25, 2025.


This rulemaking updates the PUC's Low-Income Usage Reduction Program regulations.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the PUC (66 Pa.C.S. §§ 501, 1501, 2203, and 2804) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
