The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's quarterly Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) filing submitted on September 19, 2025 to become effective on October 1, 2025. In the filing, the company is not proposing to revise its currently effective DSIC rate of 0.02%.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed DSIC rate for the three-month period of October 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to remain effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any subsequent submissions to the Commission related to this docketed case should reference Docket No. M-2025-3057584.
