Applicant's Unopposed Motion for Continuance of In-Person Hearing


Applicant, Global Logistics LLC, by and through its attorney, hereby moves the Commission for a continuance of the In-Person Hearing scheduled in this case for October 16, 2025, and in support thereof avers as follows:

1. On June 24, 2025, Applicant, Global Logistics LLC, submitted to the Commission an Application to Operate as a Paratransit Company in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (the "Application").
2. On August 4, 2025, Bux-Mont Transportation, Easton Coach Company, Suburban Transit Network, Inc., and Tri County Transit Service, Inc., filed a Joint Protest to the Application.
3. On August 14, 2025, the Commission issued an Initial In-Person Hearing Notice, scheduling a hearing in this matter for October 16, 2025, before Administrative Law Judge Francis Brady.
4. On September 19, 2025, the undersigned attorney entered his appearance in this matter on behalf of Global. See Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. Global respectfully requests that the Commission continue the In-Person Hearing for a minimum of sixty (60) days to allow time for its counsel to familiarize himself with the Application and the Joint Protest, communicate with counsel for the Joint Protestants to gain a better understanding of the factual and legal basis of the Joint Protest, to attempt to negotiate a resolution of the Joint Protest if possible, and to determine whether to conduct discovery, and if so, what discovery is necessary.

6. Counsel for the Joint Protestants does not object to a continuance of the In-Person Hearing. See Exhibit B attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Wherefore, Applicant, Global Logistics LLC, respectfully requests that the Commission continue the In-Person Hearing in this case for a minimum of sixty (60) days.






