Dear Ms. Danhires:

By Order entered July 24, 2025, the Commission authorized Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (the Company) to file a tariff supplement containing changes in rates to provide for the recovery of its costs of purchased gas, consistent with the terms and conditions of the Joint Petition for Settlement of the Rate Investigation filed in the above docket, pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 1307(f). On September 26, 2025, the Company filed Supplement No. 402 to Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C. No. 9, effective October 1, 2025, in compliance with the Order and the Commission's regulations that permit gas utilities to update their gas cost recovery rate on a quarterly basis.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 402 to Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
