Dear Ms. Snyder:

By Order entered August 28, 2025, the Commission authorized Pike County Light & Power Company-Electric Division (the Company) to file a tariff supplement in the form set forth in Appendix A to the Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement, so as to produce an annual increase in revenues consistent with the Order.

On September 17, 2025, the Company filed a supplement in compliance with the Order. On September 25, 2025, the Company refiled the supplement to correct the supplement number and make other ministerial pagination corrections. On September 29, 2025, an additional page to the supplement was filed. Supplement No. 110 to Electric-PA. P.U.C. No. 8 has an effective date of October 15, 2025.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 110 to Electric-PA. P.U.C. No. 8 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
