Application of the York County Board of Commissioners for approval of the alteration of the crossing where Mill Road crosses, at grade, a single track of Norfolk Southern Railway Company (DOT 592 279 T) in Upper Allen Township, Cumberland County by replacement of a bridge.

To Whom It May Concern:

Paragraph 3 of the Commission's Secretarial Letter dated March 8, 2024, directed that York County submit detailed final structural plans for the subject alteration for Commission approval. Paragraph 4 of the same letter directed that York County also submit final, approved detour plans for the subject alteration for review.

The final, signed and sealed plans were received by the Commission on August 28, 2025, and the York County Board of Commissioners avers that a copy of the complete set of plans were sent to all parties of record. None of the parties have advised this Commission that it objects to the final plans.

The plans were identified as "YORK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND CUMBERLAND COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS DRAWINGS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TOWNSHIP ROUTE T-913 IN YORK COUNTY FROM STA. 0+50.00 AND TO STATION 2+38.78 LENGTH 138.73 FT. 0.026 MI. AND TOWNSHIP ROUTE MILL ROAD IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY" consisting of a total of sixty-seven (67) sheets, which include eight (8) sheets of construction plans, four (4) sheets of traffic control plans, forty (40) sheets of structure plans, four (4) sheets of signing and pavement marking plans, seven (7) sheets of erosion control plans and four (4) sheets of aids to navigation plans

Please be advised that the plans have been certified as the correct plans and are hereby approved. The Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code.

Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.


All formal documents must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission. Documents must be eFiled, mailed or hand delivered. All filings should be addressed to the Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. The Commission will not accept documents delivered by fax or by e-mail. Parties are encouraged to file formal documents by eFiling with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an eFiling account through the Commission's website (the account is free of charge) and accepting eservice at <https://www.puc.pa.gov/filing-resources/efiling/>.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
