AFFIDAVIT OF KYLE BAMBERSKI

I, KYLE BAMBERSKI, swear and state the following under penalty of perjury:

1. I am currently employed by Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) as a Supervisor in the Field Services Department.
2. I have held that position since December 2017 and have been a Supervisor in the Meter Shop since 2020.
3. The PGW Meter Shop tested Meter No. 2293448 (Meter) on July 21, 2025.
4. PGW tested the Meter as part of its investigation into the incorrect billing allegations made by the Complainant, Halima Ervin, as part of her Complaint at Docket No. F-2025-3054349.
5. The meter test results show that Meter No. 2293448 tested an average of 2.2% slow
6. On August 25, 2025, PGW’s Meter Shop sent the Complainant a letter incorrectly stating that the meter tested 2.2% fast. The letter further incorrectly stated that the Complainant was entitled to a refund for any overcharge caused by the fast meter as well as the meter testing fee.
7. The meter testing slow established that the customer was not being overcharged as the result of the meter and is not entitled to a refund under 52 Pa. Code § 59.22.

8. The customer did not pay a meter testing fee and is not entitled to a refund for such.
9. I hereby certify, pursuant to 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904, that the foregoing statements are true and correct based upon my personal knowledge, information and belief.
