STATUS UPDATE

Solid Foundations Academy LLC v. Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC

Date: October 2, 2025

Peoples' scheduled construction of the mainline extension necessary to split the service at the subject property from one shared customer-owned-service-line to two distinct customer-owned-service lines and company meters, has commenced and is well underway and expected to be completed in the next two (2) weeks.

Peoples Engineering Team has been communicating with Ms. Rupert from Solid Foundations and the adjoining property owner, to ensure customer-side plumbing and ancillary work will be ready to make the new connections, without unduly disrupting the operations of the School and Church.

Counsel for Peoples spoke with Ms. Rupert on today's date and the parties request to schedule another status update for October 17, 2025. In the event all work is complete, and the Formal Complaint is fully settled before the 17th, a Certificate of Satisfaction will be filed with the Commission in lieu of a status update.
