Dear Secretary Homsher:

Pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. §2101 et. seq., Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or “Company”) hereby files for approval the enclosed confidential Affiliate Services Agreement (“ASA”) between The Efficient Network (“TEN”) and the Company. The subject agreement concerns the provision of energy efficiency projects for federal government facilities within the Duquesne Light service territory. Duquesne is seeking to assist its federal government customers improve energy efficiency, energy infrastructure, and energy security and conservation which, among other benefits, potentially lowers energy bills, and improves the environment, and helps support the goals of the Commonwealth.

The Duquesne Light Company and TEN, Inc., are both wholly owned subsidiaries of Duquesne Light Holdings. As a result of this relationship, the Agreement is subject to the Affiliated Interest Agreement provisions of the Public Utility Code. The enclosed Agreement is marked as CONFIDENTIAL ATTACHMENT A. Duquesne Light respectfully request that Attachments A be treated as confidential and protected from public disclosure as it contains competitive information.

Duquesne Light seeks approval of the Agreement to meet the conservation goals of our federal government customers on a timely basis as requests are made of the Company. Federal government facilities are required to work with regulated utilities that provide service at their specific locations. Duquesne Light entered into a competitive procurement process to provide a Utility Energy Services Contract (UESC) at certain federal facilities. DLC won the procurement contract and seeks approval of the affiliated interest agreement with TEN to meet the UESC goals. TEN has direct experience completing similar projects for other entities. Duquesne is interested in moving forward to meet the energy needs of its federal customers.

The Company requests that the Commission approve the Agreement as soon as is reasonably practicable. Duquesne is available to promptly answer any questions on this matter.


