AMENDED BRIEFING ORDER

The transcript in this matter was filed with the Commission’s Secretary on August 19, 2025. By Order dated August 20, 2025, it was established that main briefs in this matter were due on or before October 6, 2025 and reply briefs were due on or before November 5, 2025. On October 6, 2025, Vincent Mattiola (“Complainant”) submitted a request by email to extend the deadline to file his brief. Pursuant to this Order, the request will be granted.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Vincent Mattiola’s request for extension to file his brief in the matter of Vincent Mattiola v. SmartEnergy Holdings, LLC at Docket No. F-2025-3054761 is granted.
2. That Parties shall now file and serve main briefs on or before Thursday, November 6, 2025 and reply briefs on or before Monday December 8, 2025.
3. That an original copy of all briefs must be filed with the Secretary, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 5.502(b), and a copy served on the presiding officer and the other Party no later than 4:30 p.m. on the dates listed. Service can be made electronically on the presiding officer and other Party and shall be prepared in Microsoft Office Word format. Briefs shall be presented in Times New Roman size 13 font.

4. That all briefs shall comply with the requirements set forth at 52 Pa. Code § 5.501. Briefs must include proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law and proposed ordering paragraphs.

5. That the Parties are to develop and utilize a mutually agreeable table of contents for both main and reply briefs, if possible.

6. That if a Party does not file a reply brief, it will be assumed that the party does not dispute the assertions, contentions or arguments made by the other Party in their main brief. While it is not necessary in a reply brief to repeat a particular argument or discussion contained in the main brief, the reply brief should note where the responsive argument is located in the main brief and how it responds to the other party's assertions, contentions or arguments.

7. That any brief not filed and served on or before the date fixed therefore will not be accepted for filing, except by permission for good cause.
