Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:



Request for Information

1.) Question #10 of the application.

Your description of the service area is acceptable; however, the needs of the persons being transported limits service. I would encourage you to consider broadening your customer base. Please, verify that you wish to operate as previously submitted or verify that the example below is what you now intend.

Example: To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from points in Northampton County, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

2.) Under question #5 of the Applicant's Verified Statement requires that you describe your hiring and employment policies in case of expansion. Provide compliant policies that satisfy the requirements of 52 Pa Code with revision to the specific chapters below. Please review Title 52 information online, which may be accessed at www.pacode.com.

A.) § 29.503. Age restrictions. (minimum age): Will there be a minimum age requirement for drivers?

B.) §29.505. Criminal history. (schedule): After the initial check, how often will this check be done? How will you make sure it is done on a set schedule?

3.) The Statement of Financial Position.

A.) You are required to provide a dated balance sheet. The information must be comprised of information which is less than 6 months old and should consist of accurate information and not rounded numbers or estimates. The information provided is also to be strictly limited to assets and debts held by the

applicant (Four Guys Healthcare Transit LLC), and not the individual member. Any property listed must be registered or titled to the corporation – personal property should not be included. If the company has not yet been funded, then now is the time.

- B.) Provide either a signed letter from a bank officer, or a copy of an account statement (with account number redacted) verifying the funds held in the applicant's (Four Guys Healthcare Transit LLC) account. The statement or letter should also demonstrate the balance date, which must be less than six months old.
- C.) Submit proof of ownership of the claimed vehicles, such as registrations, titles, etc. Proof must be in the name of "Four Guys Healthcare Transit LLC".

Note: As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged.
