Re: Pike County Light & Power Company-Gas Division's compliance tariff

Dear Ms. Snyder:

By Order entered August 28, 2025, the Commission authorized Pike County Light & Power Company-Gas Division (the Company) to file tariff supplements producing a total increase of \$825,000 in annual operating revenues consistent with the Phase I and Phase II tariff supplements included as Appendix B in the Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Full Settlement in the above-docketed rate investigation.

On September 29, 2025, the Company filed Supplement No. 130 to Gas-PA. P.U.C. No. 6, effective October 15, 2025, to implement Phase I rates in compliance with the Order.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 130 to Gas-PA. P.U.C. No. 6 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
