To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated September 19, 2025 (*September 2025 Secretarial Letter*), the Commission issued the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero this matter. As noted in the *September 2025 Secretarial Letter*, Exceptions were to be due within twenty days of that letter (*i.e.*, on or before Thursday, October 9, 2025) and Replies to Exceptions were to be due within ten days after that date (*i.e.*, on or before October 19, 2025).

However, on October 8, 2025, the Commission received a Petition for Extension of Time to File Reply Exceptions to the Initial Decision (Petition) from Steve Frempong (Complainant). In the Petition, the Complainant requested a ten-day extension (*i.e.*, on or before October 19, 2025) due to being out of town.

The Commission's Regulation at 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 permits the Commission to grant an extension of time for good cause shown before or after the pertinent time period has expired. The Commission finds that the Complainant has established good cause for the requested extension of time. As a result, the Commission will extend the period for filing Exceptions. Therefore, Exceptions will be due no later than ten days from the date of this Secretarial Letter. Consequently, the new deadline for filing Replies to Exceptions shall be ten days from the date that Exceptions are due.
