**ORDER**

BY THE COMMISSION:

We adopt as our action the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge  
Alphonso Arnold III dated August 15, 2025;

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Formal Complaint filed by Claudio Waller in the matter of Claudio Waller v. PECO Energy Company - Gas, Docket No. C-2025-3053079 is sustained.

2. That PECO Energy Company - Gas is directed to pay a total of \$500 in civil penalties by sending a certified check or money order payable to the “Commonwealth of Pennsylvania” with the docket number of this proceeding listed on the check within thirty (30) days from the entry date of the Final Commission Order to:

3. That PECO Energy Company - Gas shall cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 101, *et seq.*, and the Public Utility Commission’s Regulations, 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.1, *et seq.*

4. That PECO Energy Company - Gas shall, within ninety (90) days of the entry of the Final Commission Order, repair Complainant’s security line damaged as a result of the gas equipment work performed on Complainant’s property on November 26, 2024.

5. Upon completion of the work described in Ordering Paragraph No. 4, PECO Energy Company - Gas shall file a compliance report at this docket number, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.591.

6. That a copy of this Opinion and Order shall be served upon the Financial and Assessment Chief, Office of Administrative Services.

7. That the Bureau of Administrative Services, Assessment Section, shall monitor this matter for compliance.

8. That, if PECO Energy Company-Gas fails to make the civil penalty payment required by Ordering Paragraph No. 2 above, within thirty (30) days of the entry date of the Commission's Final Order, it is further ordered that the Bureau of Administrative Services, Assessment Section, shall refer this matter to the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General for collection of the total set forth above and appropriate action.

9. That upon payment of the amount referenced in Ordering Paragraph No. 2 and receipt of the compliance report described in Ordering Paragraph No. 5, the Secretary's Bureau shall mark the matter at Docket No. C-2025-3053079 as closed.
