4. The proposed construction will involve a placement of an aerial fiber optic cable attached to existing Verizon poles (Exhibit A)

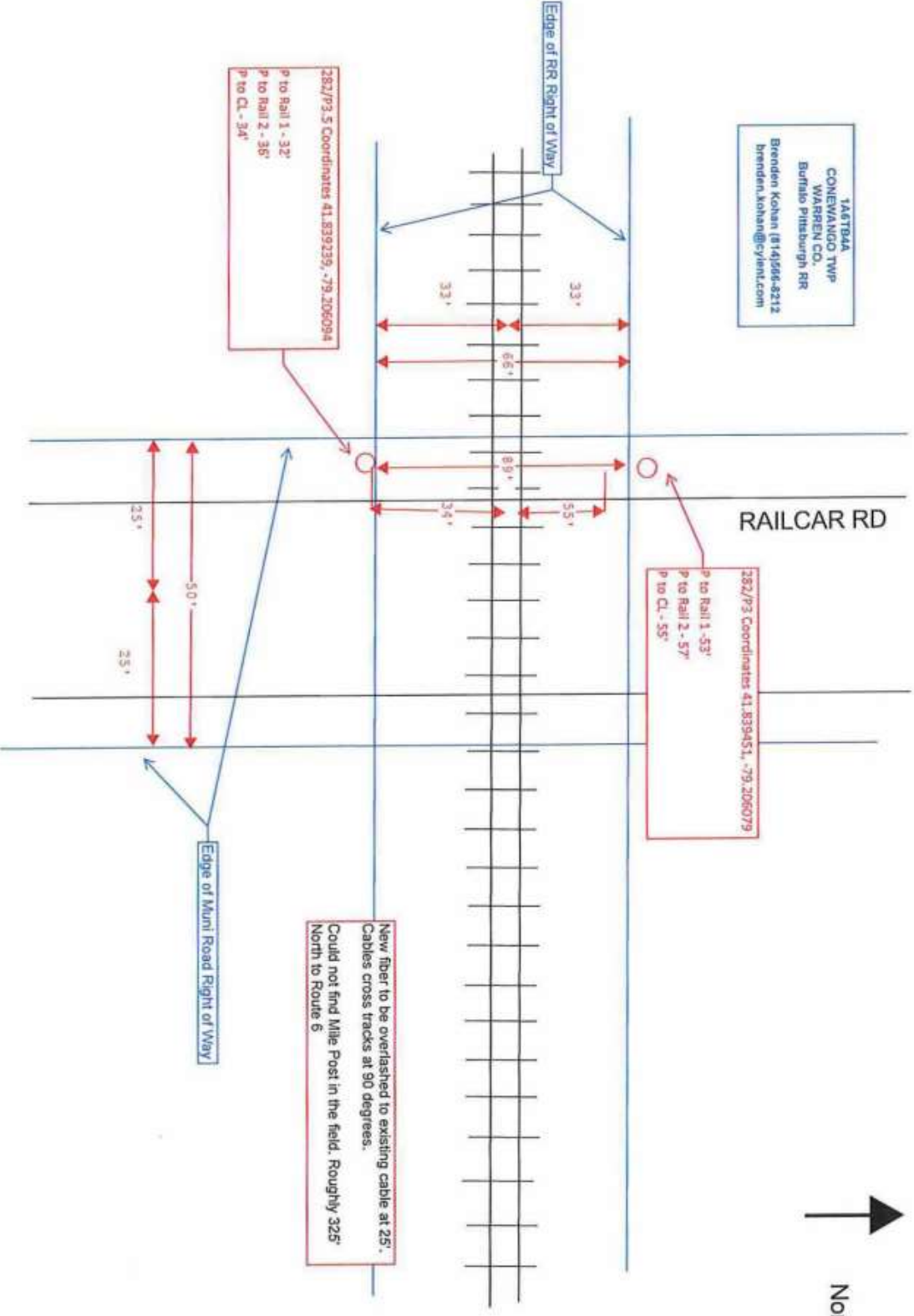
