Application of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania for approval of the alteration of the crossing where Fourth Street crosses, at grade, track of CSX Transportation, Inc. (DOT 871 029 B) by the installation of an 8 inch plastic gas line encased in a 12 inch steel pipe, in Gettysburg Borough, Adams County

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated May 17, 2024, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania (Columbia Gas) was directed to complete the subject crossing alteration on or before May 31, 2025

In a previous petition received on April 11, 2025, a representative of Columbia Gas requested the Commission extend the completion date to May 31, 2026. This request was approved by Secretarial Letter dated May 12, 2025.

In the current petition received on September 25, 2025, the representative of the applicant requests a further time extension with a new completion date of March 31, 2027, due to budgeting and the need for additional studies and permitting by other reviewing agencies.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and will grant Columbia Gas an extension of time to March 31, 2027.

**THEREFORE:**

The letter-petition received on September 25, 2025, by a representative of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania be and is hereby granted to the extent herein directed:

1. Paragraph 8 of the Secretarial Letter dated May 17, 2024, and revised May 12, 2025, which reads as follows, to wit

“8. The alteration of the crossing be completed on or before May 31, 2026, and that on or before said date Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania report in writing the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plan and this Secretarial Letter.”

be and is hereby modified to read:

8. The alteration of the crossing be completed on or before March 31, 2027, and that on or before said date Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania report in writing the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plan and this Secretarial Letter.

2. In all respects not inconsistent herewith, our Secretarial Letter dated May 17, 2024, remain in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
