2. Upon approval of the application, you will be notified that prior to providing service in Pennsylvania you must submit evidence of insurance to the Public Utility Commission. Your permanent evidence of insurance will be a Form E for bodily injury and property damage insurance. This form is mailed to the Commission directly from the home office of your insurance carrier. The name and address on your Form E must exactly match the name and address you have provided on your application. Your insurance company must subscribe to the NIC Insurance Filing website at [www.nicinsurancefilings.com](http://www.nicinsurancefilings.com). You will request the insurance company (not the agent) to file the required insurance forms electronically through NIC. Mailed insurance forms are no longer acceptable. The minimum limits of insurance are as follows:

Bodily Injury - The liability of the insurance company on each motor vehicle operated in common or contract carrier service shall be in amounts not less than \$300,000 per accident for a vehicle with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating of 10,000 pounds or less, in the case of a single vehicle, or a manufacturer's gross combination weight rating of 10,000 pounds or less, in the case of an articulated vehicle. The liability of the insurance company on each motor vehicle operated in common or contract carrier service shall be in amounts not less than \$750,000 per accident for a vehicle with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating over 10,000 pounds, in the case of a single vehicle, or a manufacturer's gross combination weight rating over 10,000 pounds, in the case of an articulated vehicle. Insurance coverage of motor carriers of household goods shall meet the requirements of 75 PA C.S. §1711 (relating to required benefits).

Cargo - \$5,000 for loss or damage to cargo being transported.

Moyer & Sons, Inc. started as a small moving company in 1969 in Maryland providing household goods moving services. We incorporated in 1976. We provide services in 48 states. We currently have 100 employees and were proud to be awarded the 2025 Independent Mover of the Year by the American Trucking Associations (ATA).

4. Describe your facilities, record maintenance plan and your communication network. Moyer & Sons, Inc. facility is located in Clarksburg, Maryland and sits on approximately fifteen (15) acres. The office machines we use for communication are VOIP phones, cell phones and computers.

The building is 42,500 square feet and has a street structure with metal walls. The facility consists of a warehouse that is 30,000 square feet with three (3) bay doors, two (2) with docks, and one (1) drive in bay. There is also a two (2) bay mechanical shop that has a pit which is 10,000 square feet that is separated by a fire wall, and our office that is approximately 2,500 square feet is also separated by a firewall. The building is equipped with cameras and is alarmed.

Moyer & Sons, Inc. maintains all records through SmartMove (a moving company software that is cloud-based), downloading files on our server, and also by filing away in our fireproof file cabinets.

We receive customer service requests via phone calls, our texting platform, emails, our website, or one of the third-party services such as Yelp, Angie's List, etc. We then dispatch crews prior to the job with the proper paperwork. We maintain continuous communication with all drivers through phone calls, texts, ELD or email. All of our trucks are equipped with GPS, and electronic logging device (ELD). Most of our fleet is also equipped with front-facing cameras.

**Page 6 – Answer to Question 5.**

We currently have a total of 50 drivers available for dispatch. We are always on the lookout for interested drivers.

- a. We prefer a minimum of one (1) years' experience in the moving industry but are also willing to train in-house. Drivers must be approved through our insurance company and pass a DOT physical and pre-employment drug test. Moyer & Sons, Inc. also is aware and will follow the provisions of Title 52 Pa. Code §29.505(a)(3) and will not hire an individual to operate a vehicle in the service of our company who was convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor under the laws of the Commonwealth or under the laws of another jurisdiction, to the extent the conviction relates adversely to that person's suitability to provide service safely and legally. This individual would be disqualified from employment as a driver. In addition, we also will follow the Commission's Policy Statement, 52 Pa. Code §41.14(6), and will apply it and will not employ any driver convicted of a felony or crime of moral turpitude and remains subject to supervision by a court or correctional institution.
- b. We use First Advantage Background Direct for our background as well as MVR checks. We also have our insurance company run an MVR check prior to hiring. We run these MVR checks upon employment and twice annually through the state of Maryland.
- c. Our driver training is a combination of in-house mentorship, JJ Keller's training program, and instructional technologies training materials that we have assembled through our years of operations.
- d. We check twice annually through the Maryland Vehicle Administration program via the Office of Motor Vehicles.
- e. Moyer & Sons, Inc. has a zero-tolerance program. We conduct quarterly random drug and alcohol testing on all employees.
