

**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY
FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA” or the “Company”) by and through its attorney, Angelina Umstead, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby files this Motion for Continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for October 22, 2025. In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. On or about July 10, 2025, Brian Russell (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) regarding 20 Lucas Drive, Littlestown, Pennsylvania 17340 (“Service Location”) under Account No. 100050471844 (“Account”).

2. On July 31, 2025, the Company filed its Answer denying the material allegations.

3. On September 10, 2025, Administrative Law Judge Steven K. Haas (“ALJ Haas”) issued a Prehearing Order setting an initial telephonic hearing date of October 22, 2025.

4. The Company has been in settlement discussions with Complainant and would like additional time to work toward resolution of this matter.

5. On October 10, 2025, the Company contacted Complainant to see if he would be agreeable to a continuance of the hearing in order to continue settlement discussions.

6. On October 10, 2025, Complainant responded to the Company that he is agreeable to a continuance in this matter.

7. As such, the Company respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for October 22, 2025, in this matter be continued to a later date to allow the parties additional time to reach a resolution.

II. MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

8. The Commission's regulations permit a request for continuance of a hearing upon good cause shown. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b).


9. In this case, the Company is seeking additional time to work toward resolution of this matter.

10. The parties have both agreed that a continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for October 22, 2025 is in the best interests of judicial economy for the Commission as well as both parties.
