**STATUS REPORT OF
DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE JEFFREY A. WATSON:

Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”) submits the following Status Report on behalf of the Company, pursuant to the Interim Order Establishing Litigation Schedule entered in this proceeding (“Interim Order”) on October 8, 2025. The Interim Order requires each party to file a status report no later than noon on October 13, 2025, that identifies all dates in which the responding party is available to participate in an in-person hearing, in Pittsburgh. Duquesne Light plans to call a minimum of four witnesses in this proceeding, in order to fully respond to the numerous claims raised by the Complainants. Duquesne Light has provided dates

in December 2025 in an attempt to provide the Presiding Officer with additional options for the hearing date(s).

Currently, Duquesne Light and its witnesses are available for an in-person hearing in Pittsburgh on November 3, 4, 11, 13, or 14, 2025 and December 1, 3, 5, 8, or 10, 2025. Regarding the December dates, the Company notes that its witness who can speak to the alleged damage claim submitted by the Complainants was unavailable provide her availability in the time frame provided in the Interim Order. The Company commits to providing an update to the Presiding Officer as soon as her availability is confirmed.

Duquesne Light respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson accept this Status Report.
