**STATUS REPORT OF
THE ELLIOTT KOGER, SR. AND ELLIOTT-TODD PARKER KOGER**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE JEFFREY A. WATSON:

Complainants submits the following Status Report on behalf of the Company, pursuant to the Interim Order Establishing Litigation Schedule entered in this proceeding (“Interim Order”) on October 8, 2025.

The Interim Order requires each party to file a status report no later than noon on October 13, 2025, that identifies all dates in which the responding party is available to participate in an in-person hearing, in Pittsburgh.

Duquesne Light, as per its continued pattern of “bad faith” waited until 11:53 am to advise the Complainant “important company witnesses are not available until December 2025.”

Complainants plan to call a minimum of ten witnesses in this proceeding. Because of the ongoing “bad faith” late notice of a hearing is not possible until the December 2025 dates (December 1, 3, 5, 8, or 10, 2025).

Regarding the December dates, an important witness who can speak to the alleged damage claim submitted by the Complainants was unavailable to provide her availability in the time frame provided in the Interim Order.
