Application of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania Inc for approval of the alteration of the crossing (DOT# 145 593 W) by the installation of an 8-inch carrier plastic gas line where Lincoln Street crosses, below grade, the tracks of Allegheny Valley Railroad Company, in Washington City, Washington County.

To Whom It May Concern:

This matter is before the Commission by reason of the above referenced application filed by Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania Inc on January 12, 2024, and docketed at A-2024-3045449.

On November 19, 2024, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania Inc notified the Commission of their desire to withdraw the application, which had been a request to alter the subject crossing by the installation of an 8-inch carrier plastic gas line under the crossing. Subsequent to filing of its Application, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania Inc has determined that it can continue to provide safe and reliable service to the City of Washington without the installation of the facilities at the referenced crossing.

Upon full consideration of the matters involved in these proceedings, we find that the application in this matter can be withdrawn.

The Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code and finds that:

1. The application filed January 12, 2024, be withdrawn.
2. The Secretarial Letter dated May 14, 2024, be rescinded.
3. The case be "CLOSED."

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.

All formal documents must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission. Documents must be eFiled, mailed or hand delivered. All filings should be addressed to the Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. The Commission will not accept documents delivered by fax or by e-mail. If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
