



**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF PECO ENERGY COMPANY**

PECO Energy Company (Respondent or Company), by and through its attorneys, Reger Rizzo & Darnall LLP, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, respectfully requests that the Honorable Emily A. Farren (Judge Farren) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) grant its Motion for Continuance (Motion) and issue an order continuing the scheduled Call-in Telephonic Hearing for October 28, 2025 (Hearing) as the Company’s fact witness, Ramona Milburn, has a long-planned vacation and is unavailable for the Hearing.

In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

1. On July 10, 2025, Elizabeth Alberts and Andrew Juleff (Complainants) filed a Formal Complaint alleging incorrect charges under Account No. 3186432222 (Account) for residential electric service provided to 7075 Phillips Mill Road, Apt. 110, New Hope, Pennsylvania (Service Address).
  
2. On July 30, 2025, the Company filed an Answer denying the material allegations therein.

3. By Notice, dated August 13, 2025, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing was scheduled for Tuesday, October 28, 2025, before Judge Farren.

4. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 (b) states:

(b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, requests for continuance of hearings or for extension of time in which to perform an act required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time by this title or by order of the Commission or the presiding officer, shall be by motion in writing, timely filed with the Commission, stating the facts on which the application rests, except that during the course of a proceeding, the requests may be made by oral motion in the hearing before the Commission or the presiding officer. Only for good cause shown will requests for continuance be considered. The requests for a continuance should be filed at least 5 days prior to the hearing date.


5. The unavailability of the Company's fact witness, Ramona Milburn, constitutes good cause consistent with Commission regulation.

6. The undersigning Counsel contacted the Complainants to notify them of the Company's need for a continuance, and they advised that they had no objection to the Company's request for a continuance.

7. The Company respectfully requests the Call-in Telephonic Hearing be rescheduled for a date after October 28, 2025.

**WHEREFORE**, for good cause shown, PECO Energy Company requests that the Honorable Emily A. Farren grant its Unopposed Motion for Continuance of the scheduled October 28, 2025, Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing.
