Re: UGI Request for an Extension to the Reply Comment Period

On October 16, 2025, UGI Utilities, Inc (UGI) filed a Petition (UGI Petition) requesting a 20-day extension of the reply comment period in the above-captioned proceeding. UGI states that the comments filed by the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) and the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) are extensive and raise several recommendations and requests for clarification UGI must address in its reply comments. UGI argues that it will have difficulty thoroughly vetting and responding to CAUSE-PA and OCA's comments without the requested extension. UGI Petition at 1-2.

UGI reports that it has consulted with the CAUSE-PA and OCA and states that neither party is opposed to the extension request. UGI Petition at 2.

Accordingly, UGI's request for a 20-day extension to the reply comment period is granted. Reply comments for all stakeholders are now due by November 10, 2025.
