Rates and Rules Governing the Transportation of Household Goods

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, household goods in use, between
points in Pennsylvania

Issued: October 14, 2025

Effective: October 15, 2025

Issued Under authority of PA Code, Title 52, Section 23.42

Rules and Regulations – Intrastate Household Goods Tariff

1. Advance Reservations

All moves must be scheduled in advance. Reservations are confirmed only when a deposit is received (see Section 9).

2. Rates and Charges

- **Local Moves (under 40 miles):** Charges are based on hourly rates, beginning when the vehicle departs the carrier's facility and ending when the vehicle returns to the facility.
- **Long-Distance Intrastate Moves (40 miles or more):** Charges are based on weight and mileage, as required by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.
- Charges may vary if services differ from the estimate. Additional items, labor, time, or complexity may result in additional charges.

3. Estimates

- Written estimates will be provided to the shipper at least 48 hours before the scheduled move unless waived in writing by the shipper.
- Estimates will be non-binding, specified in the estimate document.

4. Valuation of Goods

The carrier's liability for loss or damage is limited by the shipper's choice of valuation:

- **Option 1 – Standard Valuation:** \$0.60 per pound, per article. No charge.
- **Option 2 – Declared Value Coverage:** Shipper may declare a lump sum value for the entire shipment. Premiums are charged at:
 - **1% of declared value with a \$500 deductible**
 - **2% of declared value with a \$250 deductible**
 - **3% of declared value with no deductible**
- Extraordinary value items (jewelry, coins, cash, antiques, heirlooms, artwork, etc.) must be declared in writing in advance. Failure to declare voids carrier liability for such items.
- Carrier does not provide or sell third-party insurance. Shippers may purchase their own insurance coverage independently.

5. Articles Not Accepted for Transport

Carrier will not transport the following:

- **Extraordinary value items** not declared in advance (jewelry, coins, cash, antiques, heirlooms, artwork).
- **Perishable items** requiring refrigeration.
- **All live plants.**
- **Live animals** of any kind.
- **Firearms, weapons, live ammunition, or explosives.**
- **Hazardous materials** including but not limited to fuel, chemicals, paint, propane, flammables, and corrosives.
- Any items specifically prohibited by law.

6. Infestation and Fumigation

If goods transported by carrier are found to be infested (ants, termites, cockroaches, bed bugs, or any other dangerous/disease-bearing insect), the carrier may refuse shipment. If infestation spreads to the carrier's vehicle, the shipper shall be liable for all fumigation and related costs.

7. Impractical Operations

Carrier shall not be liable for failure, delay, or inability to perform service when caused by:

- Acts of God (natural, geological, meteorological disasters)
- Acts of war (declared or undeclared), terrorism, invasion, embargoes, blockades
- Civil disturbances, insurrections, riots, labor strikes/lockouts
- Actions of state or federal government (sanction, nationalization, embargo)
- Utility or internet outages, ferry/tunnel/bridge interruptions
- Unsafe road, highway, street, or driveway conditions
- Major construction, detours, or access obstructions
- Hazardous materials, unsafe premises, or threats of physical harm to crew

8. Inventory

- An itemized inventory will be prepared unless waived in writing by the shipper.
- The shipper affirms the inventory accurately represents items to be moved.

9. Deposits and Cancellations

- A deposit equal to **25% of the estimated charges** is required to secure a reservation.
- If cancellation occurs **more than 72 hours prior** to the scheduled move, the deposit will be refunded minus a 50% administrative fee.
- Cancellations **within 72 hours** of the move date will result in forfeiture of the full deposit.

10. Payment Terms

- Payment is due upon completion of services, subject to the following rule:
 - If the final charges exceed the estimate by more than 10%, the shipper is required to pay the estimate plus 10% (or \$25, whichever is greater) at delivery. The remaining balance will be invoiced and due within 15 days.
 - If the final charges do not exceed the estimate by more than 10%, the full balance is due upon delivery.
- Accepted forms of payment: cash, credit card, or debit card (Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover). No personal checks accepted.

11. Customer Responsibilities

Shipper must:

- Be present or represented at origin and destination
- Ensure clear access to both locations
- Disclose hazardous, restricted, or fragile items in advance
- Remove items not intended for transport
- Ensure pets and children are kept safe and away from moving operations

SCHEDULE OF RATES

For moves under 40 miles from origin to destination.

HOURLY MOVING: The hourly rate begins when the vehicle departs the carrier's facility and ends when the vehicle returns to the facility, less any breaks and/or any vehicular breakdown. A minimum of two hours of labor, plus travel time (estimated at one-half (1/2) hour per each 15 miles of travel or fraction thereof), will be charged.

Vehicle & 2 Laborers - \$149.00 per Hr.

Vehicle & 3 Laborers - \$199.00 per Hr.

Peak: (March 25th - October 1st)

Monday-Thursday:

Vehicle & 2 Laborers - \$149.00 per Hr.

Friday-Sunday:

Vehicle & 2 Laborers - \$159.00 per Hr.

Additional Unit(s) (Year Round):

Laborer - \$40/hr

Vehicle <10k GVWR - \$150 per Day

** Overtime hourly rates of time and a half apply after nine hours of labor Monday-Sunday**

Overnight Holds: \$300 per truck, per night, not to exceed 3 nights.

Governing References: Carrier's Client Management System (CMS), Arrivy, will be utilized to track mileage between moves when necessary.

Specialized Items:

- Grandfather Clock - \$75 each
- Appliances (Washer Dryer Refrigerator etc) - \$75 each
- Computer Equipped Exercise Equipment - \$75 each

Oversized Items:

- 150-250 Pounds per Item - \$75 each
- 250+ Pounds per Item - \$150 each

Rates are in dollars and cents per 100 pounds applied to actual total weight moved and include basic padding and wrapping, loading and unloading, and the actual movement or transportation of property from origin to destination.
