PETITION FOR WITHDRAWAL OF FORMAL COMPLAINT

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.94, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”), by its prosecuting attorney, files this Petition for Withdrawal of I&E’s Formal Complaint (“Complaint”). In support thereof, I&E respectfully represents as follows:

1. I&E commenced this action on July 24, 2025, by filing a Complaint alleging that Respondent advertised and held oneself out as a common carrier for transportation services by vehicle for compensation without obtaining/holding a certificate/authority from the Commission, in violation of 66 Pa. Code §1101; 1102(a).
2. On July 24, 2025, the Complaint was served upon Respondent by certified mail.
3. On or about August 11, 2025, the Commission received a returned mail envelope.
4. On August 26, 2025, the Complaint was reserved upon Respondent by standard mail.
5. Attached to the Complaint was a Notice advising the Respondent that he must file an Answer within twenty (20) days of service of the Complaint.

6. On September 11, 2025, Jorge Garcia efiled an Answer in response to the Complaint.

7. Based upon information provided by Jorge Garcia's Answer, the facts and circumstances of this case, as I&E understands them, have changed.

8. In the interest of justice, I&E desires to withdraw the Complaint that was filed in this matter.

WHEREFORE, I&E respectfully petitions the Commission for leave to withdraw the Formal Complaint in this matter pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.94.


