Note: Please restate the data request prior to providing a response. In addition, provide the name and title of the person(s) providing the response and/or information for each data request.

- A-26. PAWC's response to Data Request A-25 indicated that Phases 3 and 4's average daily demand is 16,200 gpd. In PAWC's Amended response to Data Request A-19 the quantity of meters in Phase 3 was updated from 59 5/8-inch meters to 45 5/8-inch meters and 52 one-inch meters. The quantity of meters in Phase 4 was updated from 49 5/8-inch meters to 49 one-inch meters and 60 5/8-inch meters. Please provide an updated average daily demand for the apparent 206 residential customers in Phases 3 and 4 or confirm that the projected average daily demand for Phases 3 and 4 is 16,200 gpd.
- A-27. In response to Data Request A-18, Phase 3's breakdown included 45 5/8-inch meters and 52 one-inch meters, but only 40 water service lines. Please provide an updated breakdown of water service line quantities, sizes, materials, and costs to correct this apparent discrepancy or explain why there are 57 more meters than water service lines.
- A-28. In response to Data Request A-18, PAWC identified five hydrants in Phase 3 and two hydrants in Phase 4. Please provide evidence that Jackson Township has agreed to pay these charges or has approved a subdivision plan that includes this updated amount of public fire hydrants.
- A-29. In the amended response to Data Request A-20, the copy of the revised Exhibit K attached as TUS-A-20_Attachment_Amended is not an amended copy of the revised Exhibit K in PAWC's original response to Data Request A-20. Also, the revised Exhibit K did not include revenue from the 101 one-inch water meters, the 105 5/8-inch water meters, and the seven fire hydrants for Phases 3 and 4 included in the response to Data Request A-18. Please provide a copy of the revised Exhibit K that conforms with the Phase 3 and 4 facilities included in the response to Data Request A-18.
