Dear Parties:

On October 21, 2025, UGI Utilities Inc. - Electric Division (UGI) filed a Letter Request for an extension of time to file a response to Radial Power, LLC's (Radial) Formal Complaint. The original response was due October 23, 2025. In its Letter Request, UGI averred that the parties were actively seeking a non-adjudicative resolution through mediation and that, in order to facilitate the pending settlement discussions, an extension was necessary. UGI further indicated that Radial does not object to the extension requested by UGI.

UGI's Letter Request seeks an extension for filing a responsive pleading "until 20 days after the mediation process has concluded in this matter." UGI's Letter Request for an extension of time to file its responsive pleading to the above captioned Formal Complaint is granted in part.

UGI's responsive pleadings are due to be filed with the Commission by the close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) 60 days from the date of this letter, December 22, 2025. If additional time is needed to continue settlement discussions, the parties may seek a second request for an extension.
