**ORDER REFERRING APPLICATION
FOR MODIFIED PROCEDURE**

On July 2, 2025, Global Logistics LLC (Applicant) filed an Application for Motor Common Carrier of Persons in Paratransit Service for Approval to “transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in nonemergency medical paratransit service, from points in the Counties of Chester, Delaware, Lancaster and Montgomery, and the City and County of Philadelphia, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.”

Notice of the Application was provided in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, 55 Pa.B. 4942 (July 19, 2025). Protests were due by August 4, 2025.

On August 4, 2025, Bux-Mont Transportation, Inc. (Bux-Mont), Easton Coach Company (Easton), Suburban Transit Network, Inc. (TransNet), and Tri County Transit Service, Inc. (Tri County)(collectively, “Joint Protestants”) filed a timely Joint Protest to the Application.

By Corrected In-Person Hearing Notice dated August 20, 2025, an Initial In-Person Hearing in this matter was scheduled for October 16, 2025, and the matter was assigned to me.

On September 30, 2025, the Applicant filed an unopposed Motion for Continuance to allow time for newly acquired Counsel to familiarize himself with the case and also pursue resolution.

On October 1, 2025, I issued an Order granting the Applicant's Motion for Continuance.

By Cancelled/Rescheduled Hearing Notice dated October 2, 2025, an Initial In-Person Hearing was rescheduled for January 15, 2026.

On October 17, 2025, the Applicant and the Joint Protestants filed a Restrictive Amendment and Stipulation in which the Joint Protestants agreed to withdraw their Protest to the Application based upon the Restrictive Amendment and its acceptance by the Commission. The Application was amended to clearly identify and specify the territory requested so that the authority sought shall read as follows:

For the right to begin to transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in nonemergency medical paratransit service, from points in the Counties of Chester, Delaware, and Lancaster, and the City and County of Philadelphia, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

As the Application is now unopposed, it will be referred to the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services for review and resolution pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 3.381(c).
