**INTERIM ORDER REASSIGNING PETITION  
TO THE COMMISSION'S BUREAU OF  
TECHNICAL UTILITY SERVICES**

On September 9, 2025, PECO Energy Company filed its Petition for a Finding of Necessity, pursuant to 53 P.S. § 10619 that the situation of a control building with a lavatory in connection with the new Forge Springs Substation in Upper Merion Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, is reasonably necessary for the convenience and welfare of the public. The Petition was filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at Docket No. P-2025-3057330.

By Initial Telephonic Prehearing Conference Notice issued on September 19, 2025, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Prehearing Conference was scheduled for this matter on October 21, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. and the matter was assigned to us. The Notice further specified that formal protests and petitions to intervene must be filed on or before October 13, 2025. Notice of the Initial Telephonic Prehearing Conference was provided to numerous individuals, including the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Office of Consumer Advocate, and the Office of Small Business Advocate.

On September 22, 2025, we issued a Prehearing Conference Order also advising of the October 21, 2025, Prehearing Conference. The Prehearing Conference Order was

provided to numerous individuals, including the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Office of Consumer Advocate, and the Office of Small Business Advocate.

Notice of PECO's Petition was subsequently published in the September 27, 2025, issue of the Pennsylvania Bulletin. This notice also included a copy of the Telephonic Prehearing Conference Notice and advised that formal protests and petitions to intervene must be filed on or before October 13, 2025.

No protests or petitions to intervene were filed in this matter.

The Call-In Telephonic Prehearing Conference was held as scheduled on October 21, 2025. Counsel for PECO and the Montgomery County Solicitor appeared.

During the October 21, 2025, Prehearing Conference, Kenneth M. Kulak, Esq., Counsel for PECO, requested, since no protests or petitions to intervene had been filed by the October 13, 2025, deadline, that this matter be re-assigned to the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services for review and disposition.

As PECO's Petition is unopposed, we will therefore issue the following Order reassigning this proceeding to the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services for further action.
